Spring is here, and this is my favorite time of the year. April kicks off some great outdoor activities in our community. The Annual Lancaster Bike Ride on April 9th is a great way to showcase our city to avid bike riders from all over the Metroplex. The Lancaster city council has approved a unique outdoor entertainment experience called an Aerial Park. This type of park allows patrons to move from tree to tree using zip lines. The park will be located off of Beltline Road near the Lancaster Country View Golf Course. Stay tuned for more details on when the park will open. Lancaster is near completion of the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant, which has removed structures along Ten Mile Creek that were prone to flooding.

The areas where the structures have been removed will now become open park space/green belts. The city has begun construction of sidewalks along Dallas Avenue, Veterans Memorial Parkway, and Wintergreen Road as a part of a TXDOT grant. These sidewalks will allow for safe pedestrian travel to Lancaster Community Park, inclusive of our recreation center, library, and walking trails. Additionally, the sidewalks will allow our students safe passage to Lancaster High School. Have a great April!
